AN ANALYSIS OF ENGLISH PHRASAL VERB USED IN THE LYRICS OF ELVIS PRESLEY'S SONGS

Abstract: The purpose of this research are to find: 1) the types of phrasal verb used in the lyrics of Elvis Presley songs, 2) the characteristics features of phrasal verb used in the lyrics of Elvis Presley songs. This research use descriptive qualitative method. The data were collected by documentation method. In technique of checking trust worthiness of data the researcher used triangulation. The results of this study are 1) the types of phrasal verbs in Elvis Presley's songs, there are 25 data which has been found by the researcher. The data showed that adverbial phrasal verbs is the most dominant types of phrasal verb in Elvis Presley's songs, and its about 72%. The lower is prepositional phrasal verbs with the percentages 28, 2) the characteristics feature of phrasal verbs in the lyrics of Elvis Presley's songs entitled Are you lonesome tonight and Suspicious mind is the combination is not freely formed.

I. INTRODUCTION

Thus, the research is based on the need to fill the gaps of the previous researches in researching types of phrasal verb in literary works, especially in song lyrics for the data source. The reseacher chooses Elvis Presley songs entitled Are you lonesome tonight, Suspicious mind, Don't be cruel, All shook up and Jailhouse rock because it consist of many phrasal verbs and this songs has an interesting story to study. The interesting idea is the energetic interpretation of the songs.

The songs of Elvis Presley, entered at American Music Award for favorite Pop/Rock Single. The researcher chooses this songs as data source becouse this songs provides enough data that is suitable with the topic. Based on the reason, the researcher focuses on the pharasal verb in the lyric of songs Elvis Presley.

The writer decided to analyze the types and the characteristics features of phrasal verbs. In this research the writer answered the focus of the research which are What are types of phrasal verb used in the lyrics of elvis presley songs? And What are the characteristics features of phrasal verbs used in the lyrics of elvis presley songs?

II. METHODOLOGY OF THE RESEARCH

This research uses descriptive qualitative method. Sample was taken by using library research. In collecting the data, the writer used documentation method.

III. RESULT

1. The types of phrasal verb used in the lyrics Elvis Presley's songs entitled are you lonesome tonight, suspicious mind, don't be cruel, all shook up and jailhouse rock

The researcher classified the data resultin the types, characteristics, literal and non-literal. In the types of phrasal verbs, the researcher used Gethin in Kartika theory (2018:12) which are devided into two, namely: Adverbial of phrasal verbs and Prepositional of phrasal verbs

The first, adverbial phrasal verb is a verb, which combines with an adverbial particle to form a new vocabulary item. The second, a prepositional phrasal verb is a verb with a preposition or with an adverb and a preposition to form a phrase, which like man adverbial phrasal verbs, has a meaning of its own, distinct from that of the separate words.

IV. DISCUSSION

In this research, the writer used documentation method to get the data. After analyzing and getting the result, the researcher found several phrasal verbs in Elvis Presley's songs. The data were classsified into the types, characteristics feature of phrasal verb, literal and non-literal meaning. In the types of phrasal verb, the researcher analyze Elvis Presley's song by using Gethins in Kartika (2018:12) theory. Those types are adverbial phrasal verb and preposition phrasal verb.

Furthermore, for the characteristics features of phrasal verbs the researcher analyzed by using Alwasilah in Kartika (2018:11) theory such as the combination is limited to certain particle, the combination is not freely formed, combination usually can be substituted with one-word verb. Thus, for the literal and non-literal meaning of phrasal verb the researcher analyzed by using Ahayu (2018:10) theory such as for the literal phrasal verb describes what is actually happening and non-literal not describing what is actually happening.

As the result, in the types of phrasal verbs in Elvis Presley's songs, there are 25 data which has been found by the researcher.

The data showed that adverbial phrasal verbs is the most dominant types of phrasal verb in Elvis Presley's songs, and its about 72%. The lower is prepositional phrasal verbs with the percentages 28. Then the result in the characteristics feature of phrasal verbs in the lyrics of Elvis Presley's songs entitled Are you lonesome tonight and Suspicious mind is the combination is not freely formed.
