### 1. Determiners

Determiners consisted of small group of structure word without characteristics form.

- a. Article (the, a, an)
- b. Demonstrative adjective (this, plural, these), (that, plural, those)
- c. Possesive adjective ( from pronouns, example: my, your, one,s),(from noun example: john's , the girls )
- d. Numeral adjective ( cardinal, example: four, twenty, five, one, hundred),(ordinal, example: fourth, twenty, fifth, one, hundreth)

e. Adjective of indefinite quantity (example : some, few, all, more)

## III. Al-Qur'an
